I hope that everyone had a wonderful summer! It is time to register for middle school & high school youth ministry/confirmation classes. The sessions for middle school & high school/confirmation students are twice a month on Sunday from 4:30-6:00pm+mass. Sessions start on Sunday, October 2nd and go through April 2nd (see the Middle School or High School Youth Ministry/Confirmation Calendars for session dates).

The middle school program is for students in 6th-8th grade. The high school program is for students in 9th-12th grade. The sacramental preparation/confirmation program is open to all 10th-12th grade teenagers who seek to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation or seek full initiation into the Catholic faith (Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation). We strive to implement a comprehensive program to suit the spiritual growth experience of all Catholic teenagers in a welcoming & comfortable environment.

Confirmation students will have additional sessions to attend, as well as online curriculum & service projects to complete. Families will receive more information when they attend the Parent/Teen Orientation.

The <u>Parent/Teen Orientation/Personal Safety Presentation</u> for both high school & confirmation is <u>Sunday</u>, <u>September 18th in the Teen Center</u>. Both parents and teens should attend this presentation. All families should attend from 4:30-5:15 pm. Families with students enrolled in the confirmation program will also meet from 5:15-6:00 pm to receive more information about the program.

The <u>Middle School Parent/Teen Orientation</u> is Sunday, September 25th at 4:30 pm in the Teen Center. Both parents and teens should attend this orientation. The safe environment program will be discussed, and parents will have the opportunity to preview the DVD that will be shown to students on November 20th.

We look forward to journeying with you & your teenagers in their Catholic spiritual growth. Like all parents, we hope to pass on the faith as it was passed onto us when we were teenagers. Let us know how we can help & support you during this exciting time of family life.

If you are interested in your teen attending our youth ministry programs, please return your registration forms as soon as possible! This is a tremendous help in planning and scheduling resources. I look forward to working with you and your family.
